Chair Marcoux called the meeting to order at 7:36 a.m.

Motion by McCoy, 2nd by Shuman, to approve the minutes of the July 9, 2018 meeting. Motion carried.

Interviews today for the Criminal Justice Coordinator position. Interview committee is Chair Marcoux, Vice-Chair Schlender, and County Administrator Hoff.

Diane McNamer updated the Committee on bail bond testing. Testing will continue in the small courtroom and at the Sheriff's Department if/when, there is a conflict. McNamer working with Clerk of Court staff to coordinate the calendar and testing dates.

Waiting for Bylaws and MOU updates. If the bylaws can change to allow two tribal governing board members on the CJCC, Joel Valentin is ready to join the council.

Chair Marcoux presented the Diversion Training offered by the Department of Justice in Eau Claire on September 26 and 27. DOJ is covering the cost of lodging and meals for seven attendees. The Council supports attending the training. Attendees will include Ryan Reid, John Yackel, James Schlender, Aaron Marcoux, Tom Hoff, Doug Mrotek, and the newly hired CJCC Coordinator.

The Committee discussed the process and options for an inmate to voluntarily agree to assessment and treatment.

Discussed having the new CJCC Coordinator produce a pamphlet with a list of treatment providers.
