Motion by Mrotek, 2nd by McCoy, to approve the minutes of the June 10, 2019 meeting. Motion carried

Council discussed the AB Kiosk. The County needs to provide a location for the kiosk, internet, and power. Sheriff Mrotek approved a kiosk located in the Sheriff Department Lobby. Multiple organizations can use the kiosk. Currently AB Kiosks are placed in eleven Wisconsin counties. Individuals can test on any of the Kiosks in the network and the results report back to the home county. Motion by Schlender, 2nd by McCoy, for the Criminal Justice Coordinator to proceed with the AB Kiosk subject to the County Administrators approval. Motion carried.

Criminal Justice Coordinator Diane McNamer and Deputy Richard Welsch met with Brenda Spurlock to discuss available criminal justice assessments and programing. McNamer will offer a traumatic stress & resilience class this fall to incarnated men and women. This is a proactive approach to aid inmates. Supervisor Schlender asked McNamer to meet with the new LCO Tribal Council members.

CJCC includes second LCO council member and could add the new LCO Tribal judge.

The Council discuss the findings in the Sawyer County Technical Assistance Report. The state assigned Judge Anderson to Sawyer County to handle every fourth case. Shortage of attorneys for criminal cases.
