Introduction of Co-Chairs: Jim Miller and John Saunders have volunteered to co-chair for 2016 (2017, 2018)

“Charter”- Strategy: Reviewed Draft Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan/Strategy, Committee Make-Up and Objectives, Suggested specific addition to membership (LCO) Joan will draft letter to Towns inviting the Towns to select and send a representative if they are interested in participating in the Bike/Ped efforts. Jim and John will review, finalize and send out. Suggested to revise wording of Objectives and adding a “Mission Statement”. Document (Draft) will be revised sent to members for review, completed document will be furnished to Economic Development and County Board on request.

Existing Project Status: (Quarterly Report to the Economic Development Committee):

- Bicycle Map 3rd Edition: John S. indicated that funding to design and print 5000 has been secured from, HLVACB, Hayward, Stone Lake, Winter Chambers, balance from Sawyer County. Joel Harrison and John S. will work with Advance Printing to design, proof and print have ready for distribution by June 2016.
- County B Bike/Ped Trail: Gary G. reported Pre-construction Conference April 13th, Start construction April 18th, Trail Complete in June 2016.
- LCO Bike/Ped Trail, Safe Routes to School: Amber M. reported bike trail and SRTS (2miles) combined into one project. Route revised from original plan, starts at school, proceeds north alongside of Round Lake School House Road, at approximately 1 mile south of County B then west and Northwest, ends just south of the Casino Hotel, to connect to the County B trail will be necessary to add a "Bike Route" from behind Hotel (on County K) to Junction of County Highways B and K. Some minor easement issues to resolve, expect trail completion fall 2016.
- Town of Hayward Bike/Ped Trail: Joan C. reports Application (Trail and Culvert (Birkie)) Submitted to WisDOT before 29 Jan 16, expect notification 22 April 16 if project moved to Statewide Selection Process. Do some lobbying with elected officials that could have an effect on the selection process.
- Hayward Schools Safe routes to School: John McCue reported that the completed City of Hayward Bike/Ped Trails satisfy the identified "SRTS"
- City of Hayward: John McCue reported that the planned Bike/Ped Trails for the City of Hayward are complete and currently in use by the public. Some maintenance of the older phases is required and cautioned all that in planning future trails to make sure that maintenance cost are budgeted in the appropriate departments.

Future Efforts, Projects and Programs Briefly reviewed list without discussion future project and programs. First item below has been moved to an active new project for 2016.

- Bike to Work (School) Day/Week/ Month: Bike to School Day is May 4th an Bike to Work Day (Week) is May 24th, 2016. Since limited time to undertake a major endeavor, decided to put some effort into the Bike to School for 2016. Sub Committee of Jim M., Joan C., Barb K., and Amber M. will work to advertise, communicate and encourage participation in a Bike to Work Day within Sawyer County and the School Districts in the County.
