Chair Marcoux called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m.

LCO CCS is ready for referrals and will survey inmates for possible volunteers to start treatment July 16, 2018. Sawyer County CCS is not ready.

The CJCC Coordinator position is on the Tribal Governing Board agenda for \$25,000 funding. If approved, CJCC Bylaws will need to be amended. Supervisor Schlender will draft an MOU with LCO. LCO is also looking at funding ½ of the cost of Justice Point.

The CJCC Coordinator reports to the Sawyer County Administrator and will work with Sawyer County and LCO. The position is an appointed position by the Sawyer County Administrator.

The Council discussed urine analysis testing currently done in the Health and Human Services Department. The Public Health Department can no longer maintain the increased amount of testing.

Motion by McCoy, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Shuman, for Criminal Justice Coordinator Position be developed by Administrator Hoff and Supervisor Schlender with a goal to fill the position by August 1, 2018. Motion carried
