

Draft Minutes of the meeting of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council

Chair Marcoux called the meeting to order at 7:35 a.m.

Motion by Hoff, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Yackel, to approve the minutes of the June 25, 2018 meeting. Motion carried.

The Committee discussed Justice Point and the contract presented. Justice Point will start the data collection process for the Sawyer County Pretrial Screening and Assessment Pilot Program July 15, 2018. The Tribal Governing Board will contribute \$25,000 total in 2018 for Justice Point and the CJCC position. LCO requires access to the data collected. The County Administrator will sign the contract.

The County has received several applications for the Criminal Justice Coordinator position. Interviews will be schedule in the next couple of weeks and the County Administrator will pick the interview panel.

Bail Bond Testing was in the large courtroom last week. This week it is in the small courtroom. Staff discusses testing options at weekly staff meetings.

Chair Marcoux asked the Committee members if they would support a resolution to the State of Wisconsin to increase DA staff. The Committee fully supports a resolution.

The Committee discussed how many members from the Tribal Governing Board would sit on the Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee. The TGB agrees to provide \$25,000 annually for three years. Need to remove language in the MOU regarding additional funding for Justice Point. The MOU terminates December 31, 2020.
