Motion by Olson, 2nd by Duffy to elect Pleoger Chair. Motion carried.

Motion by Pleoger, 2nd by Chisser to elect DeVries Vice Chair. Motion carried.

Motion by Olson, 2nd by Duffy to elect Chisser Secretary. Motion carried.

Pleoger reported on digital parcel mapping. They are near the end of 42-6 and still need to complete 42-7. That will leave 5 townships to complete and intend to finish in 2015 or early 2016.

Pleoger discussed that the public wants #1 to complete digital parcel mapping, #2 air photos, #3 survey records online.

Discussion about scanning county documents to be made available online to the public. Olson reported that Zoning has scanned 10 years of septic reports. Coleson reported that approximately \$20,000 is needed for a document management system. Departments would be able to scan and make the records and maps available online and inter office computers. Typical annual maintenance fees are 15-20%.

Discussion about air photo flights and that land records needs another GIS Specialist.

Motion by Nieman, 2nd by Olson to recommend to the Land, Water and Forest Resources Committee that the remaining redaction fee funds be put toward land records moderation, specifically approximately \$20,000 for the Document Management System, and approximately \$130,000 towards air photography.

Pleoger and DeVries to work with committees to hire a full time GIS Specialist,

Niemann discussed his publication Modernizing American Land Records is available online and in book form. He noted that Act 20 has helped counties with land records modernization.

Motion by Olson, 2nd by Pleoger to adjourn.
