Call to Order – Nikki Leicht called the meeting to order at 12:03 pm.

Minutes from previous meeting

Review of TAD Grant Requirements: Ms. Leicht shared a PowerPoint presentation to make initial recommendations to the CJCC committee. Key Points include the group purpose: to make a recommendation to the CJCC on the type of programming Sawyer County should implement to address SUD in the criminal justice system and to develop an outline of the TAD application by identifying resources needed and program eligibility and structure. Options that can be provided include: 1) Diversion program with continuum for low to high-risk participants (focus on SUD); 2) treatment court implementation; and 3) both diversion and treatment court. In addition, resources already in place are identified as well as the resources that are still needed.

Ms. Carlson explained the treatment court model that used to be in place in Sawyer County. The high case load was found to be too cumbersome for one judge to handle and the process was discontinued.

JusticePoint will write the application to be presented to the Criminal Justice Coordination Committee for approval. Other grants could be investigated, as well.
