Jail Report -

A written report was provided. Lt. Woller reviewed the statistics of the report; unemployment rate of incarcerated remains high at 82.4%. They are interviewing several females for positions and we hope to have one FT staffed shortly.

Criminal Justice Coordinator -

A written chart of current statistics was provided. Ms. Barry reviewed the statistics provided; they are working through the waitlist.

Health & Human Services Report -

Ms. Knowlton reported that they have been working with members of the prevention coalition between LCO and the County to develop combined efforts to work together. They have been promoting the April 21st and 22nd drug-take-back day and have become qualified to provide Narcan, looking for organizations that would be willing to receive the training. They met with law enforcement across the county to review where needle boxes should be located, and are trying to assist in finding employment for individuals transitioning out of incarceration.

Community Services Updates -

Mr. Gerber advised that mentorship efforts are being strengthened for the transition process from the program.
