Motion by Hoff, second by Mrotek to approve the minutes of the January 14, 2018 meeting. Motion carried

Discussed Ordinance Bond Schedule. Judge or board can amend \$100 base fine as needed. The minimum is \$20; maximum is \$500. New process will allow the county to retain an additional \$110 per paid citation. All codes will be imported to Sheriff Department system and as needed to CCAP. County will enforce at municipality level.

Criminal Justice Coordinator Diane McNamer meeting on February 14 at LCO with Tammy Bergum and representative from Midwest Monitoring System for patch training. February 19 is implementation date for patch.

Lieutenant Joe Sajdera reported four inmates currently out on electronic monitor. Electronic monitoring is voluntary and paid by inmate. Inmate subject to random testing. CJCC feels the program is successful.

McNamer requested approval to renew her prevention and training license. Motion by Schlender, 2nd by Mrotek, to approve the renewal. Motion carried

Northwest Wisconsin Workforce Investment Board offering job skills training course including classroom instruction for food prep and safety certification. First class will start first week of April and finish the end of April.

McNamer working on Diversion programs. Prime for Life, a risk reduction program, for first time possession of THC sponsored by ICAA. Offender pays \$200 program fee.

Working on fine-tuning the proxy process.

LCO filled the position under the Joint Jurisdiction Grant. Schlender will update at next month's meeting.

McNamer and Marcoux are attending Opioid Conference in Steven's Point February 18.
