- AFFIRMING THE NEED FOR A SECOND CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE FOR SAWYER COUNTY -

WHEREAS, the Director of State Courts of the Wisconsin Supreme Court has informed the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors that the Sawyer County Circuit Court caseload, based on the 2016 weighted caseload study, indicates a current need for two (2) judges in Sawyer County; and

WHEREAS, Sawyer county is currently authorized one (1) circuit court judge while the rate of growth of case filings in Sawyer County has consistently warranted two (2) judges since at least 2014; and


WHEREAS, the Director of the State Courts has indicated to the Chief Judge of the Tenth Judicial District that it is anticipated that in October, 2017 a bill will be introduced in the State Legislature to allocate additional judgeships; and


WHEREAS, Sawyer County's judge need has been identified as the highest in the state; and


WHEREAS, an additional judgeship is in the best interests of the citizens of Sawyer County in order to provide efficient and effective judiciary.


