WHEREAS, Section 29.889 of the Wisconsin Statutes creates a wildlife damage abatement program and a wildlife damage claim program; and

WHEREAS, these programs will operate only in those counties that choose to participate by resolution of the County Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors, that Sawyer County continue participating in the Wisconsin Wildlife Damage Abatement and Claims Program in 2018, and continuing until terminated by the County Board.






