

Resolution 2017-30

RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE A SOUTHERN LOCATION FOR THE SAWYER COUNTY AMBULANCE STATION  
AND APPROVE MOVING FORWARD WITH CONSTRUCTION OF THE FACILITY

**WHEREAS**, the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors, at the March 2017 County Board meeting,  
approved implementing a full-time ambulance service in Sawyer County; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Public Safety Committee recommends a permanent site location in the southern part of  
Sawyer County to include living quarters and garage for service vehicles; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Ojibwa, on a 26-0 vote in favor of contributing to Sawyer County approximately  
four acres of land, Part of Lot 28 of Assessor's Plat No. 1, located in the SW 1/4 – NE 1/4 and the SE 1/4 -  
NE ¼ of Section 9, T38N, R6W, Town of Ojibwa, Sawyer County, Wisconsin to use for the permanent site  
location in the southern part of Sawyer County; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Committee, with input from the interim Ambulance Director, believe the  
parcel of land the Town of Ojibwa is willing to contribute will meet the operational requirements of the  
Ambulance Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, the 2017 Capital Improvement Program budget includes \$400,000 for an ambulance garage  
and living quarters.


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors approves accepting the  
transference of title from the Town of Ojibwa for the ambulance garage and living quarters in the  
southern part of Sawyer County; and,


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors re-affirms designating the  
\$400,000 in the Capital Improvement Program budget for the ambulance facility.
