

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A COOPERATIVE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians is a Federally Recognized Indian Government organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, 25U.S.C. section 461 et seq.; and,

WHEREAS, the Lac Courte Oreilles Tribal Governing Board is the governing body of the Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians pursuant to the Lac Courte Oreilles Constitution, Article III; and,

WHEREAS, the Lac Courte Oreilles Tribal Governing Board is empowered by Article V, Section 1 (c) of the Lac Courte Oreilles Constitution to conclude agreements and negotiate with federal, state and local governments on all matters affecting the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Lac Courte Oreilles Tribal Governing Board wishes to enter into a law enforcement agreement with Sawyer County for the purpose of obtaining support and law enforcement services on the Lac Courte Oreilles Reservation; and,


WHEREAS, the Sawyer County Public Safety Committee supports entering into an agreement with the Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians and applying for the Law Enforcement Grant.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors approves entering into an agreement with the Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians for the year 2020 and obtaining State financial support for improving law enforcement of tribal areas.
