RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING USE OF ARPA FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SENIOR CENTER BUS


**Whereas**, the Sawyer County Senior Resource Center provides nutrition centers, gathering places, information, and transportation to Senior residents of Sawyer County; and

**Whereas**, transportation is provided by a current bus to both the Hayward nutrition site and for day-to-day errands four days a week; and


**Whereas**, the current bus is in poor condition and requires replacement; and

**Whereas**, the Senior Resource Center has assembled a sum of over \$30,000 earmarked for bus replacement; and

**Whereas**, time is of the essence; and **Whereas**, American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA) funds are available and fit the purpose of this purchase; therefore... Be it resolved that the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors approve a sum of \$85,000.00 of ARPA funding for purchase of a new Senior Center bus.


