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The Elder Benefit Specialist (EBS) role is unique to Wisconsin. Most states basically hire a legal firm that elders can call into statewide with questions/concerns about benefits. Wisconsin, on the other hand, decided to provide a local option in every county for older people to connect with- when they just want to know more about public or private benefits, need help in organizing paperwork to apply for benefits or would like assistance with applications, appeals and denials for benefits.

Every EBS in the Wisconsin works under a program attorney. The EBS program is umbrellaed under GWAAR, the Greater Wisconsin Agency on Aging Resources, Inc. for this purpose.

Some topics that an EBS can help with include: **Medicaid, Medicare, SeniorCare, Extra Help, Medicare Savings Programs, Food Share, Social Security, (SSI/SSDI) and more.**
